## Part B: Applications

IDPH is still processing assessments for Medication and Premium assistance.

graph TD; Q[Are you currently receiving medication or premium assistance (ADAP)?] -- Yes --> A[You don't need to re-apply!]; Q -- No --> B[If your active eligibility lapsed before February 1st and you are having issues accessing medications or covering insurance premiums, you must apply to get your eligibility back.];

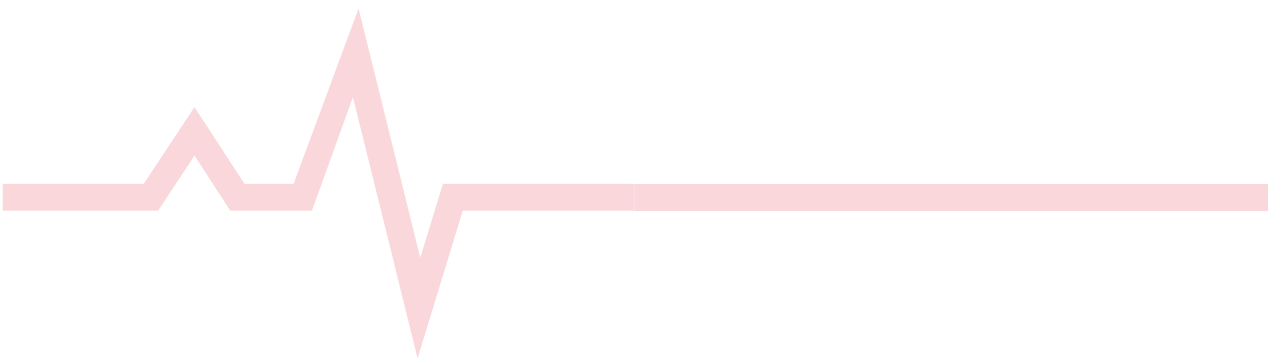
IDPH recommends *not* making any life event updates on the marketplace if you are receiving premium assistance during the pandemic!





## **Part B: Viral Load**

IDPH is now accepting viral load results taken within 9 months (instead of 6) and MAP/PAP assessments expiring at the end of March are extended for 60 days. IDPH will evaluate whether further extensions are necessary in the future.
